Meeting Notice In Compliance with 18 C.F.R. Part 358.5(a)(2)

The Transmission Provider must ensure that any employee of its Marketing or Energy Affiliate is prohibited from obtaining information about the Transmission Provider's transmission system (including, but not limited to, information about available transmission capability, price, curtailments, storage, ancillary services, balancing, maintenance activity, capacity expansion plans or similar information) through access to information not posted on the OASIS or Internet website or that is not otherwise also available to the general public without restriction.

Re: Transmission and Merchant Function Meeting with Western to Discuss Exhibit B to Grandfathered Transmission Agreement 88-LAO-376

Public Service Company of Colorado (PSCo) Transmission Function and Merchant Function will be meeting with Western Area Power Authority (Western) to discuss the transfer of responsibility from Transmission to Merchant of declaring the transmission requirements for PSCo native load under the 1988 transmission agreement with Western, 88-LAO-376. Under 88-LAO-376 each party declares annually the load points and load levels they will require from the other party. PSCo's requirements (Exhibit B) were reported to Western by Transmission Function but PSCo would like to transfer those responsibilities their Merchant Function. The proposed meeting at 10:00 am MDT on Wednesday, August 3, 2006 at Western's Loveland offices will coordinate that transfer of responsibilities. No other transmission topics will be discussed, including the load points and levels that Western uses on PSCo's transmission system.
