Southwestern Public Service Company Meeting Notice In Compliance with 18 C.F.R. Part 358.5(a)(2) The Transmission Provider must ensure that any employee of its Marketing or Energy Affiliate is prohibited from obtaining information about the Transmission Provider's transmission system (including, but not limited to, information about available transmission capability, price, curtailments, storage, ancillary services, balancing, maintenance activity, capacity expansion plans or similar information) through access to information not posted on the OASIS or Internet website or that is not otherwise also available to the general public without restriction.

In the context of discussing a possible resolution of a FERC proceeding addressing the applicability and level of Southwest Power Pool ("SPP") Violation Relaxation Limit ("VRL") charges, a conference call that will include both the Transmission and Merchant functions of Southwestern Public Service Company will be held at 2:30 CDT on September 23.

The purpose of the call is so that the Transmission and Merchant functions, along with representatives of Golden Spread Electric Cooperative and SPP, may discuss how VRLs did or did not apply during a situation that occurred in August where there was a significant loss of generation within the SPS Balancing Authority footprint, and certain related issues, such as reserve sharing response and flow gate limitations.
